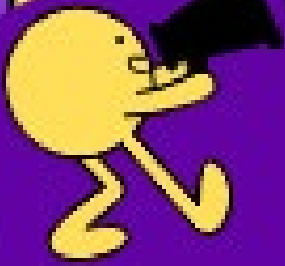

time went fast.

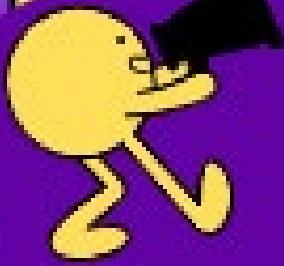
It turned to night the stars began to glow,
