I really like this place, not only because it is really organized and clean, but because they do a really good job at taking care of the place! Making this business one of the most successful in the country!

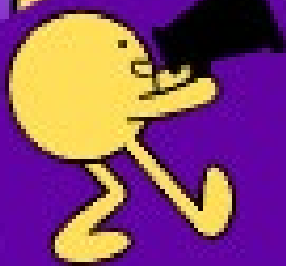

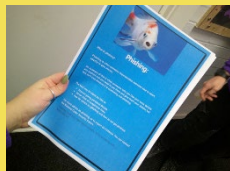
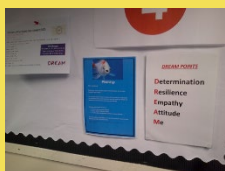
