- To master the skill of climbing.



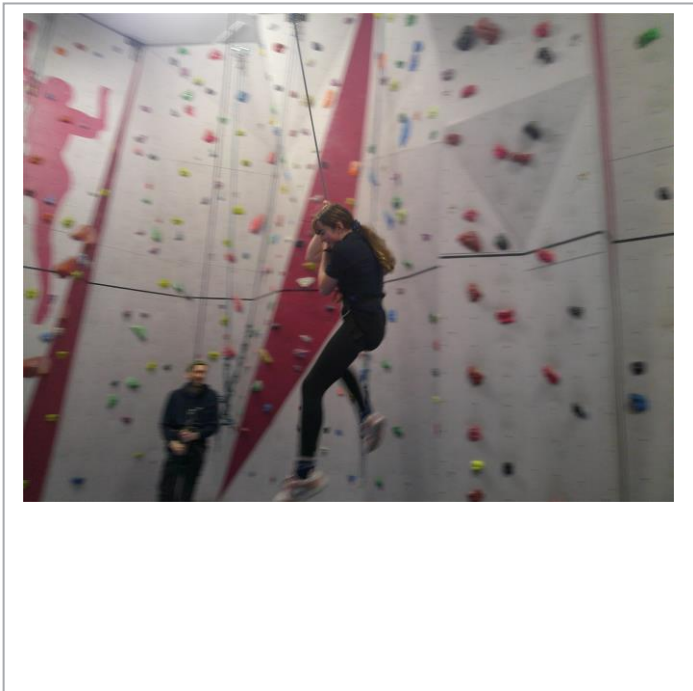
