

Sugar Art

During our Friday afternoon activities some of our young people have enjoyed attending our 'sugar art' club. Our young people are given a lump of sugar paste to then colour up with edible food colourants.

The sugar paste can then be rolled out and pressed into flowers, moulded into shapes and characters or folded and sculpted into roses. The sugar paste is then glued with edible glue. Sugar dusting powders can then be added to complete the edible creation.
