This term has been one of great change at the Cambian Hereford School not only have we see the moving forward into post 16 pathways for our year 11 pupils, we are also seeing the retirement of the schools Head Teacher after 6 years in post.

Our year 11 cohort of 4 pupils have made huge progress in their time with us and this has culminated in all 4 pupils being able to sit their GCSE examinations which finished mid-June. This represents a massive achievement for our pupils who had all arrived at the Cambian Hereford School with significant issues around attendance and negative self-image as learners. In all, the pupils were able to sit 13 separate GCSE papers covering Maths, English, Science and Psychology which shows how far the have come over their time with us and how they have developed their educational resilience which will enable them to continue positively on their individual learner journeys.

This week staff and students participated in our annual sports day, on a warm sunny afternoon at our local leisure centre in Hereford. Students took part in various track and field events including 50m, 100m, team relay, shotput, javelin, discuss and welly wanging. A fantastic afternoon enjoyed by all staff, students, parents and carers. Medals and certificates presented for excellent engagement and achievement, the pupils not only enjoyed their time at sports day and importantly were able to develop and build their social skills in a more unstructured environment.
