Do your children attend any of the following?

- Holiday clubs
- Tutors, tuition centres and supplementary schools (which may be used to support mainstream or home education).
- Extracurricular clubs such as dance, sports, drama, music, art etc.
- Uniformed youth organisations, eg, the Scouts and Guides, Cadet services
- Open access youth providers, eg, centre-based and detached youth work
- Private language schools, including those for children coming from abroad
- Religious settings which offer education in their own faith
