Primary 1

In Primary 1 this week we have been learning about Michelangelo in our art lesson. We learnt how he painted the Sistine Chapel ceiling, quite the challenge being 60 feet in the air! Michelangelo and his colleague Piero Rosselli devised system of mobile scaffolding to reach the ceiling. Inspired by his work, the children had a go

at drawing their own pictures on the underside of a table, mimicking what it would have been like to paint at such an awkward angle!



Primary 2 - Science

In Primary 2, we have been learning about the Greenhouse Effect in our topic lesson.

We conducted an investigation to see how CO2 contributed to this, by warming the Earth's atmosphere.

We used bicarbonate of soda and vinegar because we know that this releases CO2 when mixed together. Using glass jars with lids, we measured the temperature increase over intervals of 5 minutes to see if the jar with CO2 increased more than the others.





Coach House

On Wednesday night Coach House went to an Escape Room with a Titanic theme.

We went through many puzzles and challenges but ultimately solved them and we were able to escape with only 18 seconds left on the clock.



Animal Care

This week for Animal Care visited Copied Hall we Kennels to find out a little more about what their job involved. We found out about skills and qualities the required to be Assistant Manager of the kennels, from Abi. We also had the opportunity to meet her Golden Retriever, Vulcan, who travels to work every day on the bus unless he is working in his other role as a therapy dog!
